- 1. The Official and Staff Sides of the Police Negotiating Board for Scotland (PNBS) have reached agreement on pay, covering the years 2025/26 and 2026/27. The pay of senior officers, from 1 April 2025 and from 1 April 2026, is set out in the attached memorandum.
- 2. This PNBS agreement has been approved by Scottish Ministers. The Scottish Police Authority now has the authority to implement this agreement*. In due course, Scottish Ministers will make formal regulations and determinations.
